

The Department of Geography at the University of Bonn, Germany, invites applications for a tenured position

W3 Professorship in Geography

The position is to be filled starting with April, 01st, 2018.

Applicants should be internationally recognized researchers in the field of Geomatics with a specialization in Remote Sensing. A research focus on actual topics in Geography like Global Change, land degradation, or risk is desirable.

The candidate should have a demonstrated commitment to excellence in teaching and has teaching experience in Geomatics and Physical Geography. He/she will be required to contribute to all study programs in Geography and to hold courses in both English and German. The successful candidate is expected to be actively involved with academic management at all levels.

The candidate shall take the lead of the interdisciplinary Center for Remote Sensing of Land Surfaces of the University of Bonn. Applicants are expected to link to the Department's core research area Geomatics.

Close cooperation within the Department of Geography, the Earth Sciences Subject Group and various faculties is of special importance. Furthermore, we expect active contribution to the development of the geoscientific research cooperation ABC/J (Aachen, Bonn, Cologne, Jülich).

Precondition for an appointment is a habilitation thesis or similar qualifications.

Formal requirements are regulated by § 36 Hochschulgesetz (HG NRW). The University of Bonn is an equal opportunities employer. Preference will be given to suitably qualified women or handicapped people, all other considerations being equal.

Applicants for the academic position are expected to send a CV including teaching experience, research interests and a list of publications.
