WORKSHOPS

Please describe here activities conducted in 2016 (attached files compiling information and scientific and/or budgetary results can be added to the report) and workshops foreseen for the year 2017 or 2018 if already planned.

Workshops of the SIG are traditionally organized every second year. The last Workshop of the SIG was held in Stockholm at the Royal Institute of Technology from 17 to 19 June 2015 in the framework of the 35th EARSeL Symposium. The 7th workshop focused on the contribution of the remote sensing to the monitoring of the terrestrial and marine ecosystem status and its variability in the coastal zone of the European Seas. Considering the location of the workshop, particular attention has been paid to the Baltic Sea but also other topics were raised, namely: Land-Sea Interaction, new technologies and in situ measurements and ocean color models. 13 posters and 25 oral presentations have been given during the workshop. During the workshop Dr. Svetlana Spatsaeva (Moscow State University) offered the candidacy of the Museum of the World Ocean of Kaliningrad (Russia) to host the 8th workshop of the Remote Sensing of the Coastal Zone SIG Workshop in 2017. The candidacy has been accepted and now the organization of the workshop is in an advanced development stage. The conference will take place from August 31 to September 1, 2017. At the moment the MoU between EARSeL and the local organizer (Dr. Svetlana Spatsaeva) has been signed and the ConfTool has been prepared and will be operational in the next days.
